Code of Conduct

The rules and expectations detailed below are very important to the success of your lacrosse team. Please read them carefully and sign as acknowledgement of your: 1) familiarity with its contents and 2) agreement to abide by all rules and expectations:

General Guidelines:

1. **Alcohol or drug use at any time or any place will not be tolerated and is grounds for immediate expulsion from the team. Any player using drugs will be expelled from the team.**
2. Abusive language, disobeying coaches, theft, dishonesty, unsafe behavior, and fighting are not acceptable at any time and will be disciplined.
3. You are expected to support sportsmanship in lacrosse both on and off the field. Please remind supporters to show respect at our lacrosse games as well.
4. Lacrosse sticks must be in a **STICK BAG** at **ALL TIMES WHEN IN SCHOOL**. Sticks are dangerous and players with uncovered sticks in school face possible suspension from the team. **No throwing of lacrosse balls on or near school property.**
5. Your schoolwork takes priority. Plan your time so you can keep your commitment to your lacrosse team while doing your best at school.

Practice and Games:

1. You should have all equipment on and be ready to start practice at the appointed time. Late arrival disrupts practice and is unfair to your teammates and coaches.
2. **Attendance at practice will be monitored and will affect your playing time in games. If you cannot attend practice, please try to call or email your coach ahead of time.**
3. You should plan on staying for the entire practice. If you must leave early, notify a coach before you leave.
4. You are responsible for bringing your own water or sports beverage to every practice and game.
5. Roughhousing and goofing off disrupt practice and such behavior will be disciplined (running laps, push-ups, etc.).
6. At games you are expected to show the highest standard of sportsmanship. Neither opponents nor officials will be taunted or harassed in any way. No one except the coach should say anything to the referee during a game. **No "trash talking" to opponents on or off the field will be tolerated.**
7. **You are responsible for your own trash and are expected to help keep the fields clean. (This included our fields and our opponent's fields.)**
